The film is a single MP4 video file, 2.7GB in size and runs for 31mins 24 sec.

The film should first be downloaded from the Dropbox file link onto a computer (either PC or Mac) and played from that computer.

The file will play on any TV, phone or digital projector.

High Definition or Smart TVs will produce the best sound and picture.

It is important that users ensure a good working audio system is in place.

Playing via an HDMI cable will normally include audio in that single cable. Otherwise an audio cable (red and white RCA plugs) running to an audio amplifier would be required. Output from either a projector or amplifier will need to be via two speakers.

Previewing – It is essential to preview the film prior to screening to ensure your equipment is working properly.
